We gave shelter in our campus and she is living with us. We use to give her medication daily with anti-psychotic medicines. After few years of medication, she has begun to respond to the treatment and found her becoming better. She became normal and started doing her daily work by her own and communicate with others.

She felt the need to be with her daughter. We made arrangements to call her daughter, who is in other village and talked to her and made her reunite with her family and sent her home. All were happy. The daughter was happy to take her mother back to home. We are happy that after years of suffering, Chittemma became normal person and living with her family happily.
